## About this Conference

The Hawai'i Addictions Conference is designed for physicians of all specialties. It also provides topics of interest to researchers, psychologists, CSAC and other treatment counselors, cultural practitioners, nurses, social workers, students, and members of the community. The purpose of this year's conference is to engage participants in an examination of addiction medicine as a confounding influence in the reconciling of diagnosis and treatment in other specialties and disciplines.

Overall Conference Learning Objectives include being able to: 1) Identify community provider skills needed for the identification and management of addictive disorders that may be subliminal or tertiary in nature; 2) Identify testimonial skills that are of importance to psychiatrists in a forensic setting; and 3) Identify neuroimaging techniques and other initiatives that may offer translational data for clinical application in addiction management.
